




- Established in 2004 as University-wide Center

FIREFIGHTER CANCER INITIATIVE (FCI)

- Funded through State Appropriation in 2015
- Tri-County effort to understand and address excess cancer risk among firefighters
- Interdisciplinary collaboration involving six Schools and/or Departments from across the University
- Cohort of new recruits has attracted national attention and collaboration



PILOT GRANT PROGRAM

- 1. Three grants to support collaboration between diverse stakeholders to address issues of cancer disparity
- Inaugural pilot grant to support translation of evidence-based intervention into community settings BY community partners
