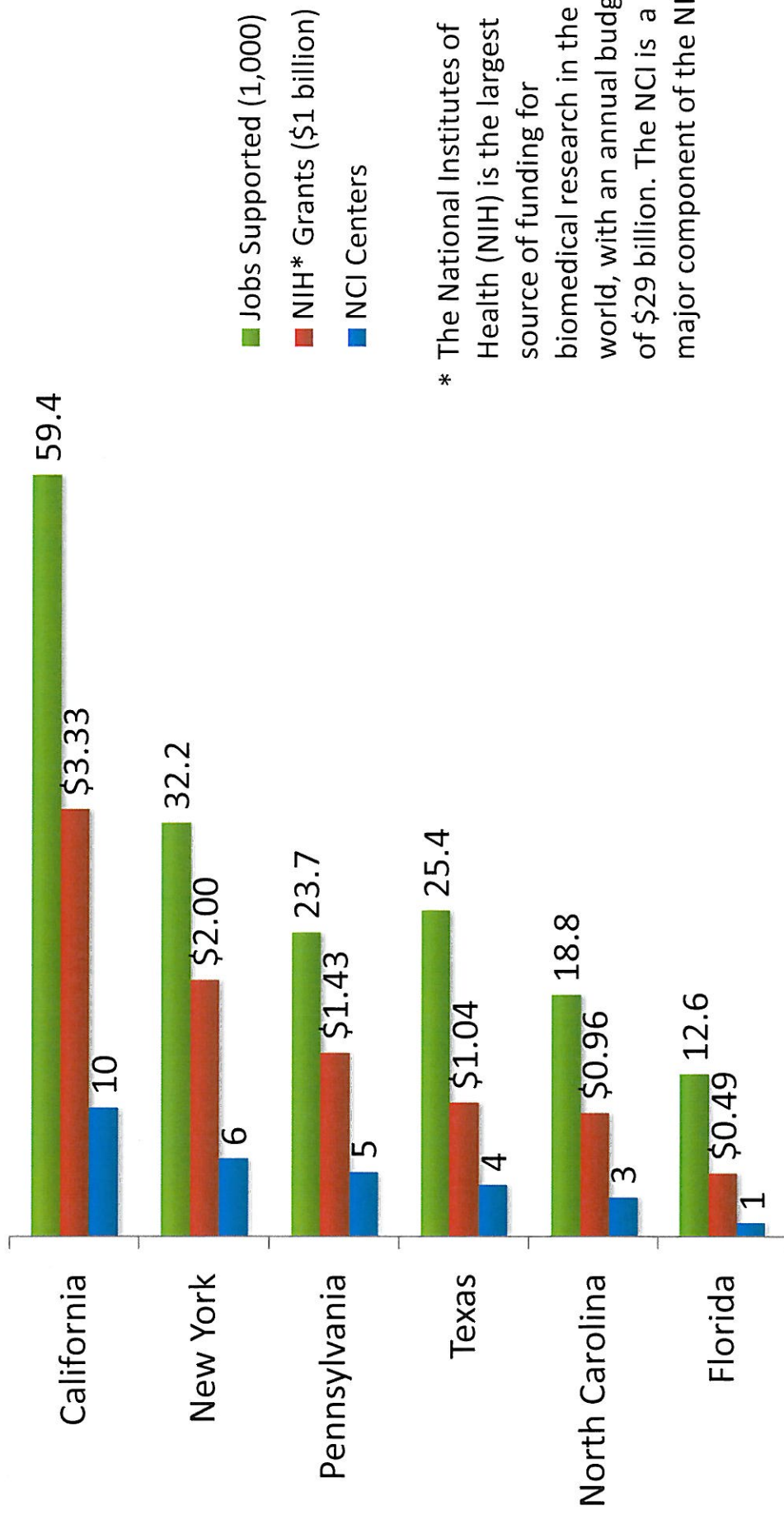

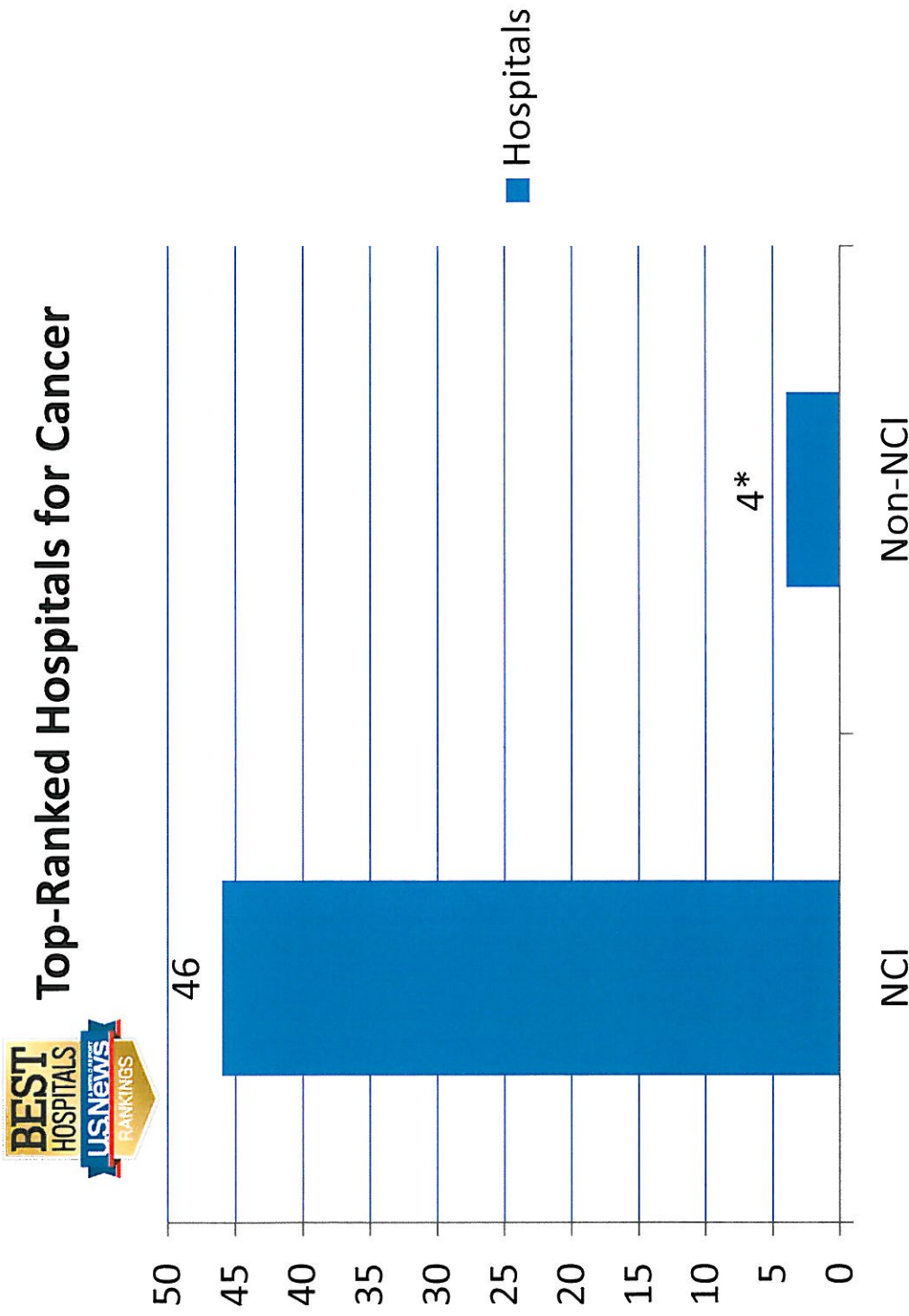
NCI Centers enhance competitiveness in research

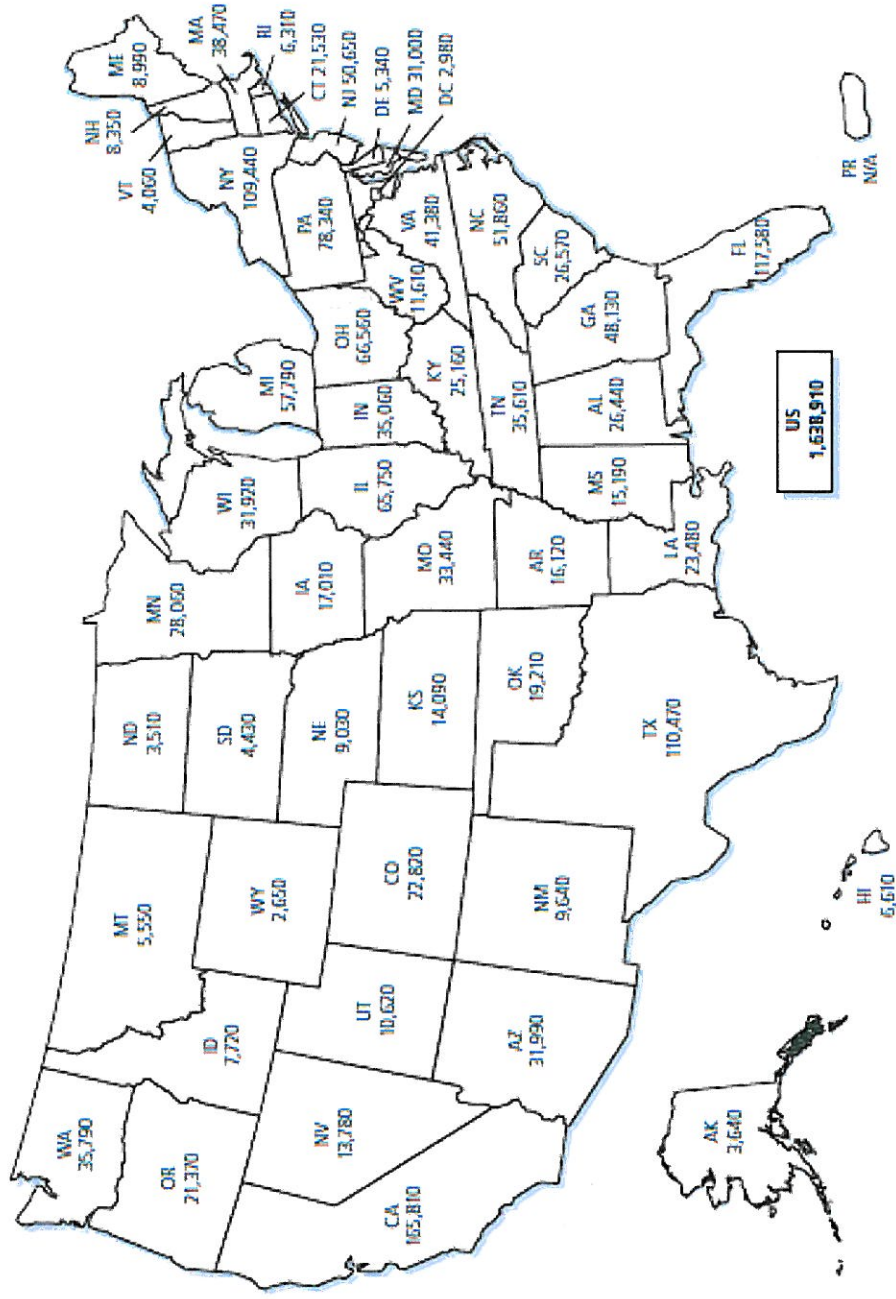
